## What's in your bag?



### Prescription Medications:

May cause a wide variety of minor to serious problems depending on the product.



### Chocolate Laxatives:

May cause severe diarrhea.



### Over-the-counter medicine:

May cause sleepiness, irritability, and agitation.

### Cigarettes:

May cause severe vomiting, upset stomach, choking, and seizures.

### Mouthwash:

Often contains alcohol. May cause low blood sugar, sleepiness, and impairment.



### Pain Medicine:

May cause sleepiness, nausea, vomiting, and affect breathing.



### Prescription Medications:

May cause a variety of minor to serious symptoms depending on product.

### Toothpaste:

May cause upset stomach if swallowed.



### Eye Drops:

May cause sleepiness, racing or slowed heart rate (depending on ingredients) and difficulty breathing.

### Hand Sanitizer:

Often contains alcohol. May cause low blood sugar, sleepiness, and impairment.
